<b>BOAR'S KLOOF CHENIN BLANC 2009</b>	£3.25	£13.50
Riebeek (Western Cape, South Africa) <i>An amazingly charismatic and lively wine with mouthwatering citrus fruit and a zesty, zingy finish to uplift lighter dishes. Could even remind you of a New World Sauvignon Blanc at great value.</i>		
<b>WILDWOOD CHARDONNAY 2008</b>	£3.50	£14.00
(California, USA) <i>If you desire some lovely warm, ripe, subtle tropical fruit with mouthfilling textures, this may be the wine for you. With plenty of body it stands up well to big flavours.</i>		
<b>VILLA WOLF RIESLING 2008</b>	£3.95	£16.00
Dr.Loosen, (Germany) <i>With this wine we get the full force of flavours that Reisling is noted for; perfumed peach and apricot fruit with a fleshy texture and refreshing finish at exceptional value.</i>		
<b>AZABACHE RIOJA VIURA 2007</b>	£3.95	£16.00
Vinedos de Aldeanueva (Rioja, Spain) <i>The Viura grape is grown mostly only in Spain where it usually features in blends. Here in the warmer and drier part of Rioja it has gentle, ripe mouthfilling fruit with a delicate yet firm finish.</i>		
<b>LASCARI GRILLO 2007</b>	£4.05	£17.00
(Sicily, Italy) <i>Light bodied and refreshing, we don't often see this Sicilian white grape on its own. Delivering warm citrus fruits and a rich finish this is a great alternative to Pinot Grigio.</i>		
<b>MIRROR LAKE SAUVIGNON BLANC 2008</b>		£19.00
(Marlborough, New Zealand) <i>A gorgeous example of the unstoppable force that is Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc. Delicate yet pronounced flavours of both cooler and warmer fruits with some fine minerality and a refreshing finish.</i>		
<b>DOMAINE LA BASTIDE VIOGNIER 2008</b>		£24.00
Guilhem Durand (Vin de Pays d'Hauterive, France) <i>A really interesting and approachable Viognier from the South of France. Quite delicate yet lively and flavourful with lightly spiced, perfumed peach fruit and a dreamy, refreshing finish. An off dry style that lends itself beautifully to lightly spiced, delicate dishes.</i>		
<b>SANCERRE DOMAINE DU P'TIT ROY 2008</b>		£28.00
Pierre et Alain Dezat (Loire, France) <i>A fine example of Sancerre with the cool, bracing fragrance of zesty lime, refreshing minerality, noticeable concentration and a delicate streak of mouthwatering acidity on the finish.</i>

<b>BOAR'S KLOOF SHIRAZ CINSAUT 2009</b>	£3.25	£13.50
<p>Riebeek (Western Cape, South Africa)  <i>This is a lighter style of red but with a fair amount of attitude.  Fully of juicy, ripe bramble fruit with hints of spice and a delicate yet lively finish.</i></p>		
<b>CENTELLEO TEMPRANILLO 2008</b>	£3.50	£14.00
<p>(Vino de la Tierra de Castilla, Spain)  <i>A light and playful style of Tempranillo, unadorned by oak and full of ripe slightly spicy cherry fruit. Deliciously supple.</i></p>		
<b>VENTISQUERO MERLOT 2008</b>	£3.80	£15.50
<p>(Central Valley, Chile)  <i>With so much Chilean Merlot around it can be difficult to know what to expect.  The Ventisquero is a more premium quality example. Medium bodied with fairly dense ripe red and black fruit, a rich texture, solid structure and a gentle finish.</i></p>		
<b>CHATEAU LA BASTIDE CORBIERES 2007</b>	£4.50	£18.50
<p>Guilhem Durand (Corbieres AOC, France)  <i>This is an expressive and approachable example of red Corbieres, from what some consider the most important region in Southern France. A blend of 70% Syrah, 20% Grenache and 10% Mourvedre this has beautifully generous bramble and cherry fruit with a spicy, savoury, herbed denseness and soft, ripe tannins.</i></p>		
<b>VALLE PERDIDO MALBEC 2008</b>	£4.85	£20.00
<p>(Patagonia, Argentina)  <i>Patagonia - "little Wales beyond Wales" is noted for its hostile and most difficult of climates. Valle Perdido are producing wines which express the purity, definition and delicacy of the fruit. This Malbec is medium to full bodied with lush, ripe and dense black fruit, asking to marry a medium rare rib-eye steak!</i></p>		
<b>SKUTTLEBUTT SHIRAZ CABERNET SAUVIGNON 2006</b>		£21.00
<p>(Western Australia)  <i>Here we have an excellent example of this blend from cooler climate Western Australia.  Lovely and rich with textured, spicy yet delicate blackcurrant and black cherry fruit.  Not too heavy and large it is quite a mouthfilling yet restrained style</i></p>		
<b>AZABACHE RIOJA CRIANZA 2006</b>		£22.00
<p>Vinedos de Aldeanueva (Rioja, Spain)  <i>A modern and stylish Rioja with plenty of savoury, concentrated, ripe red and black bramble fruit combined with noticeable cedar oak. Remarkable with most lamb dishes.</i></p>		
<b>CHATEAU MARTOURET 2006</b>		£28.00
<p>T &amp; J Lurton (Bordeaux Superieur, France)  <i>Classic Claret is hard to beat and this Petit Chateau is no exception. More Merlot in the blend makes it soft and accessible although there is some tannin to give it structure.  A good depth of ripe blackberry fruit integrated with mild oak, balanced and supple.</i></p>

<b>STEENBOK PINOTAGE ROSE 2009</b>	£3.50	£14.00

Riebeek (Western Cape, South Africa)

*Pinotage is the red grape varietal best associated with South Africa and in this pink form it is playful and moorish. Bursting with distinctive fresh strawberry and ripe cherry fruit with a zippy finish, this wine brings out the sunshine.*

<b>CHATEAU LA BASTIDE CORBIERES ROSE</b>		£19.00
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Guilhem Durand (Corbieres, France)

*More of a serious and classic rose. Lively, refreshing and enticing with rich, yet delicate and slightly spicy, warm red fruit and a crisp finish.*

<b>PROSECCO Borgo del Col Alto</b>	£4.00	£22.00

(Veneto, Italy)

*A stylish and fanciful sparkling choice. Fresh and outgoing with delicate peach and apple fruit, a creamy texture and a racy finish.*

<b>GALLIMARD CUVÉE RESERVE BRUT NON VINTAGE</b>	£7.50	£38.00
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*Gallimard are a family of growers in Champagne striving to produce Champagne in an artisanal way using mostly Pinot Noir. Delicious and full of refreshing exotic fruit with a persistent, racy finish to stimulate the tastebuds, this is an ideal aperitif.*

DESSERT	70ml Glass	1/2 Bottle
<b>375 ml LATE HARVEST SAUVIGNON BLANC</b>	£2.80	£13.00

(Maule Valley, Chile) (5+)

*We don't see many dessert wines made from Sauvignon Blanc but with heightened levels of acidity, it can produce a lighter more delicate style.*

*Light bodied and floral with ripe citrus fruit and lovely acidity on the finish.*

<b>375 ml ESSENSIA ORANGE MUSCAT</b>	£5.50	£29.00
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Andrew Quady (California, USA) 5+

*The producer, Andrew Quady is well known for his imaginative styles of dessert wine and this Orange Muscat is unusual and fascinating. The delicate yet powerful warm orange fruit provides a focus of penetrating intensity yet is bright and playful.*

*A wonderfully decadent compliment to any dessert, or well worth trying on its own..*
